

WELDER/FABRICATION SPECIALIST

Summary:

Duties primarily involve welding processes, but also include operating basic hand tools, component assembly, operating metal fabrication equipment including saws, drills, grinders that are associated with steel fabrication. Foreman will ensure the productivity of daily operations. This involves working closely with the project management team to determine labor needs, deadlines for specific tasks and enforcing safety protocols among the project team. The ideal candidate will be able to review and interpret contract documents, oversee and assign daily tasks, and foster an environment of diversity, equity and inclusion. This person must have a construction background and be able to travel for out-of-town work. Experience in the water and wastewater industry is preferred.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Perform welding operations using several welding processes
- Operate basic hand tools and powered hand tools; i.e., drills, grinders, etc.
- Operate equipment as described in company procedures; i.e., metal cutting saws, torches, drills, material handling equipment, grinders, etc.
- Perform work safely and follow established work procedures
- Perform housekeeping duties

- Perform general tasks as assigned by Supervisor
- Support the Quality Control and Safety programs

- Able to perform physically demanding work
- Ability to communicate orally
- Ability to work in cold environments.

- Must be punctual and possess a strong work ethic
